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Sempena Sidang Kemuncak ASEAN ke-46 yang berlangsung di Kuala Lumpur pada 26–27 Mei 2025, **APPGM-SDG telah memainkan peranan aktif memacu agenda SDG di rantau ini.** Melalui siri mesyuarat dan acara yang dihadiri rakan ASEAN dari Indonesia, Filipina, Thailand dan negara lain bersama dengan Malaysia. Kami mengangkat usaha komuniti dalam memobilisasi SDG demi pemeraksanaan ekonomi dan kesejahteraan bersama.

Dalam tempoh ini, kami berkongsi kejayaan dan cabaran, serta mendokumentasi **amalan terbaik di peringkat akar umbi—memaparkan solidariti dan ketahanan komuniti ASEAN** dalam memperbaiki kehidupan.

Usaha penting lain ialah penyediaan **Pelan Tindakan SDG-SSE ASEAN (2026–2030)** bersama 21 organisasi yang menandatangani MoU, komited untuk merealisasikan dalam tempoh lima tahun. Society for Asian Solidarity Economy dan MySDG Academy akan menerajui koordinasi pelaksanaan pelan ini.

*In conjunction with the 46 th ASEAN Summit under the chairmanship of Malaysia held in Kuala Lumpur from May 26 and 27, 2025; **APPGM-SDG secretariate also actively promoted this event by way of hosting a series of meeting and events which saw ASEAN partners participating especially for Indonesia, Philippines and Thailand along side with Malaysia.***

*We sought to advance the localising of SDGs together with community mobilisation for economic empowerment. During the gathering we shared our achievements and challenges. In addition, we have documented the best practices at the community level. These illustrate the solidarity among **ASEAN communities and their resilience to improve their wellbeing.***

*During these days we sought to prepare an **ASEAN SDG-SSE Roadmap (2026 to 2030)** as a clear agenda with goals and targets for joint action and cooperation. Over 21 organisations signed an MoU to make a pledge for its realisation over the next five years. The Society for Asian Solidarity Economy and MySDG Academy will play a role in the effective coordination of the Roadmap events.*

1 Sidang Kemuncak Belia SDG Malaysian-ASEAN 2025

Malaysian-ASEAN Youth SDG Summit 2025



Menghimpunkan 300 orang belia, pemimpin komuniti dan rakan korporat, Sidang Kemuncak Belia Malaysia-ASEAN SDG 2025 telah menyaksikan pelancaran rasmi WAY Forward—sebuah inisiatif pembangunan belia yang digerakkan melalui Perkongsian Awam-Swasta untuk memobilisasi peranan belia dalam mempercepatkan pencapaian Matlamat Pembangunan Lestari (SDG) menerusi kerjasama merentas sektor (SDG 17).

Sidang kemuncak ini disokong oleh Pasukan Negara PBB (UN Country Team), Kementerian Belia dan Sukan (KBS), serta lebih 43 organisasi rakan strategik. Majlis ini dirasmikan oleh YB Saifuddin Abdullah (Timbalan Pengerusi APPGM-SDG); Ts. Dr. Nagulendran Kangayatkarasu (KSU KBS); Mr. Robert Gass (Penyelaras Pemastautin PBB a.i. dan Wakil UNICEF Malaysia serta Wakil Khas ke Brunei Darussalam); Dr. Francis Ng (Perunding Botani, 1 Utama); dan Ms. Pinyada Reiniger (Kaunselor, Kedutaan Diraja Thailand) bersama sekretariat penganjur APPGM-SDG. Dilaporkan oleh Astro Awani dan RTM, sidang ini mengangkat kepentingan Pendidikan untuk Pembangunan Lestari serta kerjasama antara generasi dalam membina masa depan yang inklusif dan mampan.

Gathering 300 youth, community leaders, and corporate allies, the Malaysian-ASEAN Youth SDG Summit 2025 marked the official launch of WAY Forward—a youth development initiative powered by Public-Private Partnerships to mobilise youth accelerating SDGs through partnerships for goals (SDG 17). With support from the UN Country Team, KBS, and over 43 partner organizations, the summit was inaugurated with the presence of YB Saifuddin Abdullah (Deputy Chair of APPGM-SDG); Ts. Dr. Nagulendran Kangayatkarasu (KSU KBS); Mr Robert Gass (UN Resident Coordinator a.i. and Representative, UNICEF Malaysia and Special Representative, Brunei Darussalam); Dr. Francis Ng (Botanical Consultant, 1 Utama); Ms. Pinyada Reiniger (Counsellor of the Royal Thai Embassy) and the organising secretariat of APPGM-SDG. Covered by Astro Awani and RTM, the summit amplified the importance of Education for Sustainable Development and intergenerational collaboration.

4 SDG Labs pada Sidang Kemuncak Belia SDG Malaysian ASEAN Youth 2025

Empat sesi SDG Labs telah menghimpunkan para belia dalam bengkel interaktif yang memberi ruang untuk berfikir, mencipta dan mencadangkan solusi berasaskan SDG dalam tema perbincangan sumbangan belia dalam pembangunan komuniti, politik, pendidikan tinggi, dan kerjasama pelbagai pihak.

The four SDG Labs brought together youth in an interactive workshop to ideate, create, and co-develop SDG-based solutions along the themes of discussion on youth contributions to community development, politics, higher education, and multi-stakeholder collaboration.

The activity showcased the power of partnership with youth in amplifying and accelerating the SDGs.

2 ASEAN SDG-SSE Forum 2025

Forum ASEAN SDG-SSE 2025



Forum ASEAN SDG-SSE 2025 telah menjadi medan penting dalam membentuk masa depan Ekonomi Solidariti Sosial (SSE) sebagai strategi pembangunan mampan serantau. Mengumpulkan 110 peserta dari 7 negara ASEAN bersama ASEAN + (Japan dan China) termasuk wakil kerajaan, CSO, akademik, dan koperasi, forum ini menjadi titik permulaan bagi pembangunan ASEAN SDG-SSE Roadmap 2026–2030.

Forum ini menjadi titik permulaan kepada pembentukan Peta Jalan SDG-SSE ASEAN (2026–2030) melalui pendekatan partisipatif yang mendengar suara komuniti akar umbi dari seluruh rantau. Seramai 110 peserta mewakili 9 negara ASEAN termasuk penggubal dasar, akademik, koperasi, dan organisasi masyarakat sivil telah berganding tenaga membentuk hala tuju bersama.

Peta jalan ini dibina berdasarkan lima dimensi utama—*People, Prosperity, Planet, Peace, and Partnership*—yang masing-masing meneliti pencapaian, cabaran, pemacu (enablers), dan strategi untuk meluaskan impak SDG dan SSE. Fokus turut diberikan kepada dasar dan perundangan, pembiayaan inovatif, penilaian impak dan data, pembangunan kapasiti, serta pengurusan institusi.

Sebanyak 21 organisasi menandatangani MoU bagi menjayakan pelaksanaan peta jalan ini. MySDG Academy dan Society for Asian Solidarity Economy bertindak sebagai penyelaras bersama. Filipina akan menjadi tuan rumah forum susulan pada tahun 2026 semasa memegang kerusi Pengerusi ASEAN, diikuti oleh Indonesia pada tahun 2027.

The ASEAN SDG-SSE Forum 2025 served as a pivotal platform in shaping the future of Social and Solidarity Economy (SSE) as a core strategy for sustainable development across the region. Bringing together 110 participants from 7 ASEAN countries and ASEAN + (Japan & China) — including government officials, civil society organisations, academics, and cooperatives—the forum marked the starting point for the development of the ASEAN SDG-SSE Roadmap (2026–2030).

This roadmap was developed through an inclusive, participatory process that centred grassroots voices from across the region. Delegates collaboratively charted a shared direction for strengthening SDG and SSE in ASEAN's development agenda.

Structured around five key dimensions—People, Prosperity, Planet, Peace, and Partnership—the roadmap explores current achievements, challenges, enabling conditions, and transformative strategies to scale the impact of SSE. It also places strong emphasis on policy and legislation, innovative financing, impact measurement and data, capacity building, and institutional governance.

A total of 21 organisations signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) pledging to support the roadmap's implementation. MySDG Academy and the Society for Asian Solidarity Economy were appointed as joint coordinators. The Philippines will host the next forum in 2026 during its ASEAN Chairmanship, followed by Indonesia in 2027.



The opening was attended by YB Deputy Minister of Economy, the Advisor of PPMPL, representatives from APPGM, MySDG Academy, ASEC, and other strategic partners.



MySDG Academy and the society of Asian Solidarity Economy Council (ASEC) formally signed an MoU as founding partners to implement the ASEAN SDG-SSE Roadmap 2026-2030, solidifying their commitment to promote the Social and Solidarity Economy across ASEAN.



21 regional stakeholders collectively signed the MoU with MySDG Academy and ASEC, joining forces to localize the SDGs and co-develop academic, grassroots, and policy-driven initiatives under the roadmap. Deputy Chair of APPGM-SDG, YB Saifuddin, witnessed this..



Forum ASEAN SDG-SSE 2025 direka bentuk dengan pendekatan berstruktur dan partisipatif, menggabungkan sesi pemikiran strategik, perkongsian komuniti, dan pembentukan dasar bersama.

The ASEAN SDG-SSE Forum 2025 was structured as a multi-layered participatory platform, blending high-level insights, grassroots storytelling, and collaborative policy development.

Hari pertama forum dibuka dengan tiga sesi utama yang diterajui oleh pemimpin-pemimpin terkemuka: wakil daripada UN ESCAP dan ILO memberikan pandangan kritikal tentang hubungan antara SDG dan Ekonomi Solidariti Sosial (SSE), diikuti oleh Dr. Ben (ASEC) dan Dr. Richard (Pejabat Penyelaras PBB Malaysia) yang membentangkan kemajuan dan cabaran SDG di rantau ini.

Day 1 began with three cornerstone sessions led by prominent resource persons. Representatives from UN ESCAP and ILO offered critical perspectives on linking the SDGs with Social and Solidarity Economy (SSE), followed by Dr. Ben (ASEC) and Dr. Richard (UNRC Malaysia), who grounded the discussion in the region's SDG progress and implementation challenges.

Sebagai kesinambungan kepada ASEAN SDG-SSE Forum 2025, bengkel roving ini membawa ilmu dan semangat ekonomi solidariti sosial (SSE) terus ke akar umbi. Diadakan secara bergerak merentas beberapa lokasi strategik, bengkel ini memberi peluang kepada komuniti setempat untuk memahami, meneroka dan mengaplikasikan prinsip SDG dan SSE dalam konteks harian mereka.

Bersifat interaktif dan berbentuk pembelajaran bersama, setiap hentian menampilkan pembentangan, simulasi kes, dan sesi sumbang saran yang memperkukuh pemahaman konsep “tiada siapa yang tertinggal.” Sebanyak 19 kajian kes dari seluruh ASEAN telah dipersembahkan. Peserta dapat berinteraksi secara langsung dengan pengurus projek dan menyelami inovasi SSE dari komuniti akar umbi.

As a dynamic extension of the ASEAN SDG-SSE Forum 2025, the roving workshop brings the knowledge and spirit of the social solidarity economy (SSE) directly to communities. Held across multiple key locations, it creates space for local stakeholders to engage with, explore, and apply SDG and SSE principles in their everyday realities.

Designed to be interactive and co-learning in nature, each stop includes presentations, case simulations, and participatory discussions—reinforcing the SDG commitment to “leave no one behind.” A total of 19 case studies from across ASEAN were presented. Participants engaged directly with project managers and explored lived experiences of grassroots innovation.





Hari kedua Forum ASEAN SDG-SSE 2025 membuka ruang dialog yang mendalam dan berstruktur melalui dua sesi Working Group Discussions dan satu sesi plenari.

Perbincangan Kumpulan 1 membincangkan isu teras berdasarkan lima dimensi SDG — People, Prosperity, Planet, Peace dan Partnership. **Perbincangan Kumpulan 2** pula memberi tumpuan kepada aspek pelaksanaan dan ekosistem sokongan: dasar dan perundangan, pembiayaan untuk SSE, data impak, pembangunan kapasiti dan pengurusan institusi. Sesi seterusnya yang dipengerusikan oleh Prof. Dato' Dr. Rashila menyatukan hasil dari kedua-dua kumpulan perbincangan. Ia menjadi medan penting untuk menyelaraskan input pelbagai pihak ke arah draf Pelan Tindakan ASEAN yang berasaskan keadilan sosial, ekonomi komuniti, dan kelestarian serantau.

Day Two of the ASEAN SDG-SSE Forum 2025 served as a pivotal moment in crafting the ASEAN Community SDG-SSE Roadmap 2026–2030.

Working Group Discussion 1 tackled five core SDG dimensions: People, Prosperity, Planet, Peace, and Partnership. **Working Group Discussion 2** shifted focus to ecosystem enablers — exploring policy and legal frameworks, financing strategies for SSE, impact data systems, capacity building, and institutional management. The final session, again moderated by Prof. Dato' Dr. Rashila, synthesized outcomes from both groups. It marked a crucial step toward building a people-powered, regionally coherent roadmap aligned with SDG values and SSE transformation pathways.

The exhibition featured two distinct competitions:

1. **World Harmony Photography Awards** – an international platform founded by Bishop Prof. Dr. Dennis Ng (Victory Ministries Foundation Ltd., Hong Kong), under the International Journal of Harmony and Humanity initiative.
2. **Malaysian Harmony Photography Competition** – a national-level showcase featuring local talents portraying peace and unity within Malaysia’s diverse communities and cultural contexts.

Slot dibawah Forum ASEAN People yang dianjurkan oleh MySDG Academy dan APPGM-SDG memfokuskan kepada kluster tematik ke-17 iaitu Inklusiviti & Kelestarian dalam Ekonomi & Pembangunan. Isu utama yang dibincangkan terbahagi kepada tiga topik penting: Memajukan Ekonomi Sosial & Solidariti – Memperkukuh Pembangunan Inklusif & Mampan di ASEAN, Penyelesaian Akar Umbi dalam Tindakan – Memperkukuh Keselamatan Makanan & Pembangunan Berasaskan Komuniti di ASEAN, serta topik berkaitan dengan Pengukuhan Kerjasama Serantau & Integrasi Polisi yang menjadi fokus utama selama dua hari Forum ASEAN SDG-SSE. Ketiga-tiga topik ini berjaya menarik perhatian lebih daripada 80 peserta, yang bersama-sama berkongsi idea dan pengalaman untuk memperkasakan pembangunan yang inklusif dan mampan di rantau ASEAN.

The slot under ASEAN People Forum organized by MySDG Academy and APPGM-SDG focused on thematic cluster 17: Inclusivity & Sustainability in Economy & Development. The key thematic issues were divided into three main topics: Advancing Social & Solidarity Economy – Strengthening Inclusive & Sustainable Development in ASEAN, Grassroots Solutions in Action – Strengthening Food Security & Community-Based Development in ASEAN, and the theme covering Strengthening Regional Collaboration & Policy Integration during the two-day ASEAN SDG-SSE Forum. These three topics engaged over 80 participants, who collectively shared ideas and experiences to promote inclusive and sustainable development across the ASEAN region.



Five panelists received their certificates after completing Panel Discussion 1 on the topic Advancing Social & Solidarity Economy – Strengthening Inclusive & Sustainable Development in ASEAN.

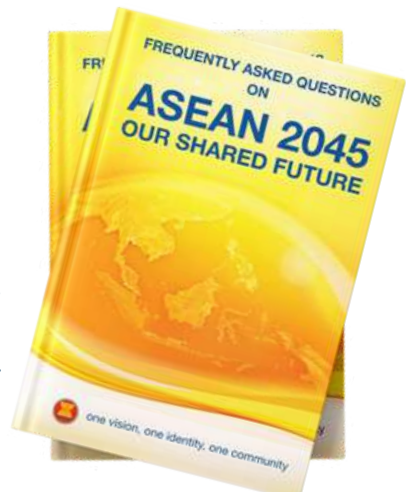
6 Deklarasi Kuala Lumpur mengenai ASEAN 2045: Masa Depan Bersama Kita

Kuala Lumpur Declaration on Asean 2045: Our Shared Future



Sebagai salah satu daripada 12 wakil CSO yang dijemput khas oleh YAB Perdana Menteri, Zoel Ng dari APPGM-SDG mengambil bahagian dalam pelancaran ASEAN 2045. Dokumen ini menetapkan hala tuju serantau ke arah kemakmuran bersama, keamanan, dan daya tahan, dan penglibatan kami mencerminkan pengiktirafan terhadap suara masyarakat dalam visi ASEAN masa depan.

Zoel Ng of APPGM-SDG stood proudly among the 12 CSO representatives specially invited by the Prime Minister for the ASEAN 2045: Our Shared Future launch. The document outlines ASEAN's forward-looking vision for prosperity, peace, and resilience. Our presence affirmed the critical role of civil society in shaping ASEAN's future.

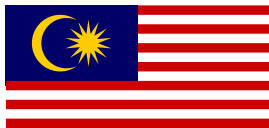

Malaysia elected as a President Of UN-Habitat Assembly (June 2025 - June 2027 session)

YB Tuan Nga Kor Ming, in his capacity as the Minister of Housing and Local Government, will represent Malaysia and preside over the Assembly as President for a two-year term from June 2025 to June 2027

YB Tuan Nga Kor Ming, dalam kapasiti beliau sebagai Menteri Pembangunan Kerajaan Tempatan, akan mewakili Malaysia dalam Perhimpunan Program Penempatan Manusia Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu (UN-Habitat) dan telah dipilih untuk mempengerusikan Perhimpunan tersebut sebagai Presiden bagi sesi Jun 2025 – Jun 2027. Pelantikan bersejarah ini menandakan peranan kepimpinan Malaysia yang semakin menyerlah dalam memajukan pembangunan bandar lestari, perumahan mampu milik dan tadbir urus tempatan yang inklusif di peringkat antarabangsa. Kepresidenan ini mencerminkan keyakinan global terhadap dasar progresif Malaysia serta sumbangan aktif negara dalam agenda-agenda dunia seperti Matlamat Pembangunan Mampan (SDG) dan Agenda Bandar Baharu.

YB Tuan Nga Kor Ming, in his capacity as the Minister of Housing and Local Government, will represent Malaysia at the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat) Assembly and has been elected to preside over the Assembly as President for the June 2025 – June 2027 session. This milestone appointment highlights Malaysia's growing leadership role in advancing sustainable urban development, affordable housing, and inclusive local governance on the global stage. His presidency reflects international confidence in Malaysia's progressive policies and its active contribution to global agendas such as the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the New Urban Agenda.

Pada bulan Mei, APPGM-SDG telah menjalankan lawatan tapak di beberapa kawasan parlimen, termasuk Stampin, Sabak Bernam dan Padang Rengas. Pemetaan isu ini merupakan langkah awal dalam proses penyetempatan Matlamat Pembangunan Mampan (SDG) oleh APPGM-SDG. Gerak kerja ini dimulakan dengan penglibatan aktif Ahli Parlimen di kawasan-kawasan terlibat. Laporan lawatan tapak boleh dimuat turun melalui kod QR yang disediakan.

In May, APPGM-SDG conducted site visits across several parliamentary constituencies, including Stampin, Sabak Bernam and Padang Rengas. This issue mapping exercise marks the initial step in the localization of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by APPGM-SDG. *Activities of Zones & Regions highlight the implementation of SDG localization efforts across Malaysia through initiatives carried out at the zonal and regional levels. Each zone has conducted issue mapping sessions, inter-agency dialogues, and capacity-building workshops involving key stakeholders, including Members of Parliament, government agencies, communities, and academic institutions. **This approach strengthens cross-sector collaboration and builds a sustainable grassroots support ecosystem.***

All initiatives are carried out with continued support from the APPGM-SDG Headquarters, which provides technical guidance, communication materials, and strategic monitoring.

Antara isu utama yang diketengahkan ialah fasiliti belia, kadar pengangguran, harga perumahan tinggi, kebajikan warga emas, kemahiran pengurusan kewangan, kapasiti sekolah, dan fasiliti kesihatan warga emas. Turut hadir Ketua Penolong Pegawai Daerah Puan Sharliza bt Wahab, Penolong Pegawai Daerah (Tanah) En Zulkamal b. Hassan, serta Penyelaras Tempatan Permatang Pauh Cik Nurul.

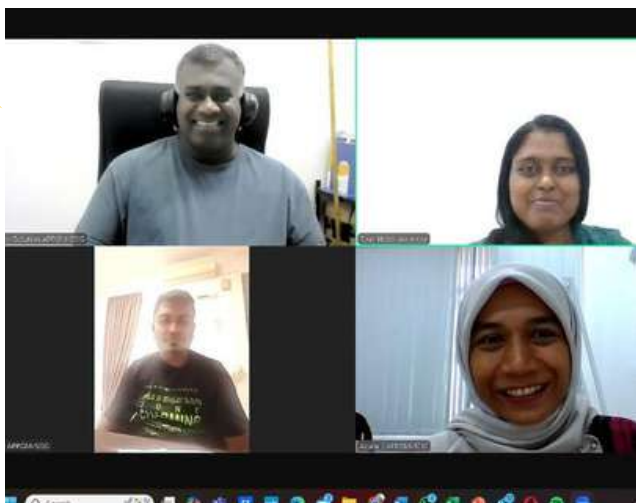

Jabatan Penyelaras Parlimen telah mengadakan kunjungan hormat dan berjumpa Tuan Haji Mohd Zaini bin Haji Ramli, Pegawai Daerah dan Tanah Kulim di Pejabat Daerah Kulim untuk membincangkan kerjasama pemetaan isu di Parlimen Kulim Bandar Baharu (P018). Pegawai Daerah berkongsi gambaran sosioekonomi di bawah pentadbiran PDT Kulim termasuk Zon Industri dengan anggaran 40-50 ribu pekerjaan, cabaran kesesakan lalu lintas, peningkatan kos sara hidup, isu banjir kilat dengan solusi yang mencabar, serta kebimbangan terhadap belia yang hilang arah dan memilih pekerjaan tidak tetap yang berpotensi menjadi kekangan masa depan.

The Constitution Coordination Department (CCD) held a courtesy call with Tuan Haji Mohd Zaini bin Haji Ramli, Kulim District and Land Officer, at the Kulim District Office to discuss cooperation on issue mapping in the Kulim Bandar Baharu parliamentary constituency (P018). The District Officer shared socio-economic insights under the Kulim District Office administration, including an industrial zone employing an estimated 40,000 to 50,000 workers, traffic congestion challenges, rising cost of living, flash floods with complex solutions involving land ownership and JKR operations, and concerns over youth lacking direction and opting for unstable jobs that may pose future constraints.

Kumpulan ini merangkumi nelayan darat; komuniti Kampung Terap dan Junjung; pesawah; komuniti Padang Tembak dan Bagan Sama; komuniti eko-pelancongan di Sedim; penduduk ladang di kawasan Estate Sungai Ular, Batu Lintang dan Some; komuniti B40 di bawah KEDA; serta peneroka sawit dan getah di Gunung Pongsu dan sekitar Kulim.

Dr. Thanaraj held a profiling and strategic planning session with YB Tuan Roslan Hashim to discuss the direction and groundwork for programme implementation in the Kulim Bandar Baharu parliamentary constituency (P018). During the session, eight target groups were identified to support issue mapping and community-based solutions. These include inland fishermen; the Kampung Terap and Junjung community; paddy farmers; the Padang Tembak and Bagan Sama community; the ecotourism community in Sedim; estate residents from Sungai Ular, Batu Lintang and Some; B40 groups under KEDA; and smallholders of oil palm and rubber in Gunung Pongsu and surrounding areas in Kulim.

The project was initiated by the CBDP team in 2024 to create an inclusive and outstanding learning environment for the students. Pathmaloshini, Mr. Elias (Solution Provider), and Dr. Ponnei (SISC+ Officer, Language – Learning Sector). Following the launch, the APPGM-SDG team witnessed 10 student groups conducting various science experiments and explored other school developments including the Digital Library and STEM Room.

Key issues from APPGM-SDG's mapping across 6 constituencies were discussed with DBKL town planners, covering topics such as urban farming regulations, affordable housing for growing B40 populations, universal design for persons with disabilities, parking challenges in high-density areas, and the need for gender-sensitive planning. The session provided clear policy feedback and strengthened our understanding of how community data can shape local development frameworks. It marks an important step toward inclusive and sustainable city planning through collaboration between policymakers and grassroots researchers.

Selain itu, pencemaran udara turut berlaku akibat aktiviti pembakaran bahan terpakai untuk mendapatkan mineral seperti tembaga.

Anthony Tan and Ms. Syadhira from the MySDG Centre for Environment and Sustainability (CES) attended a dialogue session with 11 local leaders including Penghulu Mukim Kapar, Village Heads and Secretaries to further discuss land, water, and air pollution issues in the Kapar area. A key concern raised was the severe pollution of the river in Kg. Batu 4 due to untreated waste disposal, which has caused the once-clear river to turn green and black. Previous water quality assessments revealed alarmingly low readings. Air pollution was also reported due to open burning of used materials to extract minerals such as copper.

Pada 29 Mei 2025, sesi FGD hari pertama melibatkan empat komuniti utama iaitu Komuniti Felda Neram 1, Komuniti Orang Asli Kampung Sungai Pergam, Komuniti warga emas dan ibu tunggal, serta Komuniti belia. 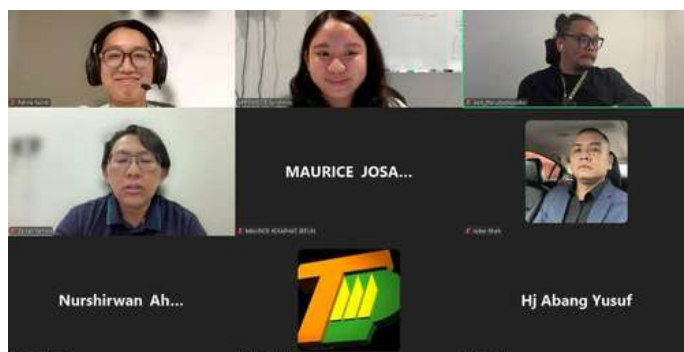

Pusat SDG Sarawak telah berjaya menganjurkan Tayangan Dokumentari sempena Program Bulan Mei. Dokumentari yang ditayangkan bertajuk “Plastic Waste, Deforestation and Floods – Indonesia’s Environmental Disasters” oleh DW Documentary yang membincangkan krisis alam sekitar di Indonesia, khususnya isu pencemaran plastik, penebangan hutan, dan banjir. Sesi ini telah disertai oleh 10 ahli Kelab Khidmat Komuniti dari UiTM Kota Samarahan yang diketuai oleh Mohamad Nur Fikry dan diiringi oleh penasihat kelab, Madam Sarehan. Selepas tayangan, para peserta secara aktif berkongsi refleksi mereka, mengaitkan isu dalam dokumentari tersebut dengan persekitaran tempatan—antaranya isu pembuangan sampah ke sungai, kepentingan kesedaran alam sekitar, dan peranan belia sebagai agen SDG di universiti.

The Sarawak SDG Centre successfully hosted a Documentary Screening as part of its May Programme. The featured documentary, “Plastic Waste, Deforestation and Floods – Indonesia’s Environmental Disasters” by DW Documentary, explored Indonesia’s environmental crises, focusing on plastic waste, deforestation, and flooding. The session was attended by 10 members of the Community Service Club from UiTM Kota Samarahan, led by Mohamad Nur Fikry and accompanied by the club’s advisor, Madam Sarehan. After the screening, participants actively shared their reflections, connecting the documentary’s issues with their local environment—such as river dumping, the urgency of environmental awareness, and the vital role of youth as SDG agents on campus.

5.5.2025

Parlimen Stampin: Pemetaan Isu – Persatuan Veteran ATM Cawangan Bau*Stampin Parliament: Issue Mapping – Malaysian Armed Forces Veterans Association (PVATM), Bau Branch*

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APPGM-SDG telah mengadakan sesi FGD ke-6 bersama Persatuan Veteran Angkatan Tentera Malaysia (PVATM) Cawangan Bau bagi pemetaan isu setempat. Antara isu utama yang dibangkitkan termasuk kekurangan dana kebajikan untuk veteran dan keluarga, ketidakpadanan pencen bagi pesara sebelum 2013, pengiktirafan kemahiran yang tidak meluas di sektor awam, serta sokongan kesihatan mental yang masih terhad. Isu berkaitan pelaksanaan tidak konsisten hak milik tanah di bawah PMAT 1973 turut disuarakan. Cadangan penambahbaikan termasuk peningkatan kadar elaun Pingat Jasa Malaysia (PJM) sebagai bentuk penghargaan alternatif, serta keperluan program penjaan pendapatan yang lebih menyeluruh bagi menangani ketidakpastian ekonomi pasca-persaraan.

APPGM-SDG conducted its 6th Focus Group Discussion (FGD) with the PVATM Bau Branch as part of the issue mapping process. Key concerns raised included insufficient welfare funding for veterans and families, pension disparities for pre-2013 retirees, lack of recognition for military-acquired skills, and limited mental health support. Participants also highlighted inconsistent implementation of land entitlements under PMAT 1973 and proposed raising the Pingat Jasa Malaysia (PJM) allowance as an alternative form of recognition. There is also a pressing need for sustainable income-generation programmes to support veterans facing economic insecurity post-retirement.

7.5.2025

Bengkel Perumusan Dasar Pembangunan Bandar Sarawak*Formulation of Sarawak Urban Development Policy Workshop*

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Raine Melissa Riman dan Dr Eva Kristin telah menghadiri Workshop Perumusan Dasar Pembangunan Bandar Sarawak yang dianjurkan oleh UNDP (Malaysia dan Bangkok) serta Kementerian Sumber Asli dan Pembangunan Bandar (MUDeNR). Sesi ini memberi peluang untuk membincangkan cabaran dan peluang dalam pembangunan bandar di Sarawak, serta menggariskan dasar-dasar utama untuk memacu pembangunan mampan.

Raine and Dr Eva attended the Formulation of Sarawak Urban Development Policy Workshop organized by UNDP (Malaysia and Bangkok) and the Ministry of Natural Resources and Urban Development (MUDeNR). The session provided an opportunity to discuss the challenges and opportunities in urban development in Sarawak and outline key policies to drive sustainable development.

9.5.2025

Parlimen Lubok Antu: Dialog Antara Agensi*Lubok Antu Parliamentary: Inter-Agency Dialogue*

Cik Jacqueline telah memberi taklimat mengenai projek yang menggunakan bahan plastik kitar semula untuk anyaman, yang diterima dengan baik oleh komuniti. Lawatan turut meninjau hasil kerja Sugu Tinggi dari Fasa 2, di mana peserta melalui tiga fasa iaitu Latihan Asas, Fasa Reka Bentuk Pertengahan dengan Sugu Tinggi Kumang, dan akan menyusul Fasa Reka Bentuk Lanjutan.

The Sarawak office visited Rumah Kuchun Jabey to introduce the handicraft makers to Tanoti's representative, Ms. Jacqueline, Tanoti's Stakeholder Manager. Ms. Jacqueline briefed the community on the project involving recycled plastic weaving, which was well received. The visit also showcased completed Sugu Tinggi from Phase 2, where participants progress through three phases: Basic Training, Intermediate Design with the taller Sugu Tinggi Kumang, and the upcoming Advanced Design phase.

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Satu sesi pemerkasaan dan perancangan strategik intensif telah dijalankan selama dua hari bagi Penyelaras Tempatan Sarawak sebagai persediaan menghadapi sesi kunjungan hormat bersama Residen dan Pegawai Daerah. Usaha ini merupakan langkah penting ke arah penubuhan Jawatankuasa Multi-agensi Intervensi Dasar Pelbagai Peringkat di peringkat bahagian seluruh negeri. Sesi ini memberi tumpuan kepada strategi komunikasi yang lebih berkesan serta pemahaman mendalam terhadap ekosistem tadbir urus di Sarawak, agar pelaksanaan dasar kekal relevan dengan konteks setempat. Peserta turut mengimbas semula kandungan utama daripada Taklimat Penyelaras Tempatan di Hotel Armada sebelum ini bagi memastikan pendekatan yang selaras dan konsisten sepanjang fasa pelaksanaan.

An intensive two-day capacity-building and strategic planning session was held for Sarawak's Local Coordinators to strengthen their readiness for upcoming courtesy calls with Residents and District Officers. These engagements are a key step in establishing the Divisional Multilevel Policy Intervention Committees across the state. The session focused on sharpening communication strategies and deepening understanding of Sarawak's governance ecosystem to ensure interventions remain contextually grounded. Participants also revisited key content from the earlier Local Coordinators Briefing held at Armada Hotel, reinforcing consistency in approach as implementation begins.

15.5.2025

Temubual Utama bersama Persatuan Kesihatan Mental Sarawak (MHAS)

Key Informant Interview with Mental Health Association Sarawak (MHAS)

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Sebagai sebahagian daripada pemetaan isu di Parlimen P196 Stampin, Raine Melissa Riman dan Dr Eva Kristin telah menjalankan temubual bersama Pengerusi MHAS, Dr Ng Boon Seng dan Timbalan Pengerusi, Dr Azizah Saie di Kuching. Sesi ini memberi perspektif pengamal terhadap isu kesihatan mental di kawasan bandar seperti Kuching. Sejak 1980-an, pendekatan pemulihan berasaskan komuniti telah menjadi amalan bagi membantu pengintegrasian individu ke dalam masyarakat berbanding pengasingan institusi. As part of the issue mapping exercise in P196 Stampin, Raine Melissa Riman and Dr Eva Kristin conducted a key informant interview with MHAS Chairman Dr Ng Boon Seng and Deputy Chair Dr Azizah Saie in Kuching. The session provided practitioner insights on mental health issues in urban areas like Kuching. Since the 1980s, rehabilitation for societal integration has been prioritized over institutionalisation for individuals with mental health disorders. Key recommendations include strengthening community resilience through programs like PLKN or community service, and fostering communication skills from early childhood. Early exposure to tech gadgets, they noted, may hinder the development of these vital skills.

The proposed project focuses on working with incarcerated youth, teaching them the traditional Sarawakian art of making keringkam—a rubia gauze fabric shawl embroidered with golden or silver threads, traditionally worn by Sarawakian Malay women.

Anthony Tan and Ms. Syadhira from the MySDG Centre for Environment and Sustainability (CES) attended a dialogue session with YB Halimah Ali and several Village Heads to discuss environmental issues in the Kapar Parliament, following last year's issue mapping and RTD discussions. The discussion revealed that only 10% of factories in Kapar are officially registered. Recently, there was a chemical explosion at one factory and a paint factory fire in the Taman Kapar Bestari and Sungai Kapal Indah areas.

Anthony Tan and Ms. Syadhira from the MySDG Centre for Environment and Sustainability (CES) attended a dialogue session with the Penghulu Mukim Meru, Village Head of Meru, and Secretary to discuss land, water, and air pollution issues in Mukim Meru, following the session with YB Halimah Ali on 7 May 2025. The discussion highlighted glove manufacturing factories as the most numerous industrial activity in Meru. Concerns were raised regarding land status as many agricultural and residential areas have been converted into factory sites. An unsustainable drainage system has caused major floods up to four times annually since 2021.

The Food Security Unit visited two impactful projects in the Central Zone. In Sungai Besar, DMT Enterprise's home-based egg farming, led by Muhammad Saufi bin Zakaria, has entered Phase 2 focusing on breeding their own chicks to enhance food self-sufficiency. Biosecurity best practices, such as separating chicks by age and health, were observed. In Shah Alam, the Anggerik Apartment Community Garden led by Akar Umbi Global has successfully produced chili and leafy greens through fertigation and hydroponics, with active community participation supporting sustainable urban food production.

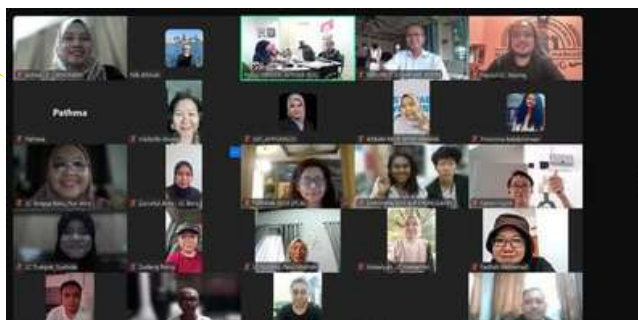

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Wakil-wakil dari Unit Advokasi Dasar (PAU) di bawah APPGM-SDG, iaitu Lydia, Nuha, dan Nadzmi, telah menghadiri Program Perkongsian Pengetahuan mengenai Advokasi, Pengumpulan Dana, dan Mobilisasi Sumber di Suruhanjaya Keterangan Malaysia. Dato' Dr. Hartini turut berkongsi petikan dari bukunya bertajuk 'The Foundling'.

The representatives from the Policy Advocacy Unit (PAU) under the APPGM-SDG, Lydia, Nuha, and Nadzmi, attended a Social Exchange Pilot Programme: Knowledge Sharing Series on Advocacy, Fundraising, and Resource Mobilisation at the Securities Commission Malaysia. The session was led by Dato' Dr. Hartini Zainudin, Co-founder of Yayasan Chow Kit. Dato' Dr. Hartini is a children's rights activist, actively addressing issues faced by at-risk children, including abuse, trafficking, neglect, and statelessness. The session focused on how non-profit organizations (NGOs) can operate effectively in advocating for the rights of communities. She also discussed the importance of narrative in attracting public and stakeholder engagement for advocacy and resource mobilisation. PAU representatives also had the opportunity to engage with Dato' Dr. Hartini on the issue of statelessness among children based on her experience in the non-profit field. 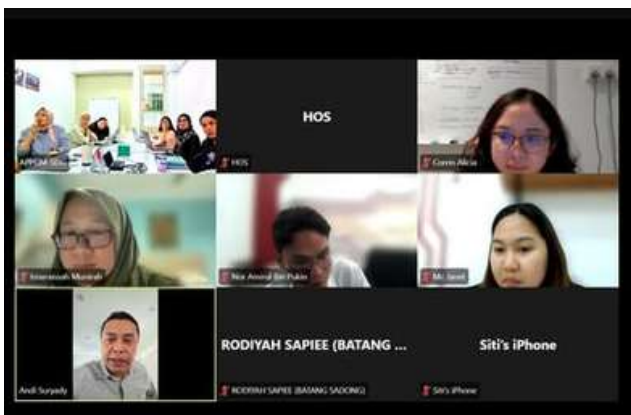

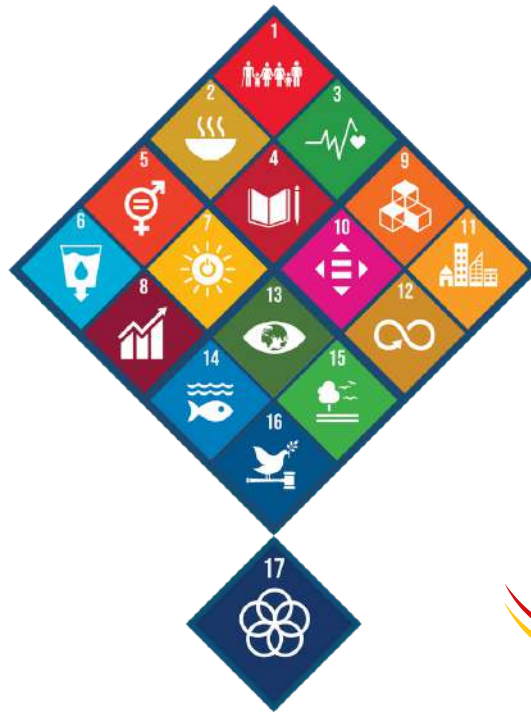
