This publication stands as more than a compilation of data; it is a testament to the partnerships, perseverance and shared vision that have driven our initiatives from concept to tangible community impact.

Under my direction, and with the strong support of Central Zone Head Dr. Teo Lee Ken, our dedicated project officers, Shaidatul Sahira and Dana Dumpangol for the Food Security (FS) Unit, and Faiz Hadzim Ag Mokti for the Community-Based Development Project (CBDP) Unit, have demonstrated exceptional commitment in implementing and monitoring projects. Their responsibilities have gone far beyond administrative oversight; they have worked closely with our solution providers through regular monthly monitoring, and have gone on the ground to observe, assess and support project activities. These efforts have ensured that every initiative remains aligned with our objectives and responsive to community needs.

Equally, I extend my deepest appreciation to our solution providers, whose dedication to partnership embodies the spirit of SDG 17, Partnerships for the Goals. In the Food Security (FS) Unit, the Central Zone has successfully implemented 23 projects, comprising 21 farming initiatives and 2 animal breeding projects. These have been delivered with the expertise and commitment of 22 solution providers, reaching a total of 253 beneficiaries. Each project is designed to address local food needs, strengthen supply chains and equip communities with the knowledge and resources to secure their own nutritional future. The results demonstrate the value of targeted interventions supported by capable partners who share our vision for a food-secure society.

In the Community-Based Development Project (CBDP) Unit, the Central zone has delivered 53 projects, spanning 18 social, 33 economic and 2 environmental initiatives. These were made possible through the involvement of 53 solution providers and have benefited 1,242 individuals across 27 parliamentary constituencies. The breadth of this work reflects our commitment to holistic community development, fostering inclusion, economic empowerment and environmental stewardship. Together, these efforts contribute to a stronger, more resilient Central zone, equipped to face present challenges and future opportunities.

**AQUA STAY ENTERPRISE**



**Solution Provider:**

Aqua Stay Enterprise was established in 2022 and has experience in the aquaculture industry, with its main focus on the sale of freshwater fish and fish fry. The company also conducts aquaculture training courses and engages in collaborations, including a joint venture with the District Fisheries Department and the Department of Education through Vocational Colleges.

**Project Description:**

- Collaborated on 'Menternak Ikan Keli Dalam Kanvas', a project that introduces catfish farming using a canvas tank system as a new, simple, and inexpensive innovation in aquaculture. The canvas tanks are easy to install and manage, and are effective in controlling water temperature, which promotes good fish growth. This method allows farming to be conducted in any location with an adequate water supply, eliminating the need for heavy machinery or extensive construction.

**Project Impact:**

- New employment and income enhancement opportunities were created for the participants.
- Experience and skills in farming catfish within canvas tanks were provided to the participants.
- A community of farmers was established to meet the high market demand for fish.
- Contributes to SDGs 2, 8 & 17.

**Solution Provider:**

Established on October 4, 1974, PIBG SMK Sungai Besar focuses on educational development and ensuring student success within the Sungai Besar parliament.

**Project Description:**

- PIBG SMK Sungai Besar
- Collaborated on 'Kelas Tuisyen SPM' project, a project which addresses the issue of 9%-13% of students in the Sungai Besar Parliament area failing to obtain their SPM certificate annually due to failing Bahasa Melayu and/or Sejarah. The program gathers these students to motivate them, offers intensive extra classes, and provides training on correct exam-answering techniques to help them pass these core subjects.

**Project Impact:**

- The number of students who obtained better academic results increased, enabling them to pursue higher education and better career opportunities.
- Students' motivation and awareness regarding the importance of the SPM certificate were successfully increased.
- Students' confidence was enhanced, and they were equipped with effective techniques to answer exam questions for Bahasa Melayu and Sejarah.
- Contributes to SDGs 1, 4 & 17.



**Solution Provider:**

DMT Enterprise established in 2024, the organisation actively pursued knowledge in poultry farming. The organisation also developed its egg incubator machine, enabling the production of high-quality day-old chicks (DOC) for future stock. These efforts reflect growing expertise and self-sufficiency in poultry farming.

**Project Description:**

- Collaborated on the “Projek Ternakan Ayam Penelur”, which the project aims to establish a community-led egg production initiative in Sabak Bernam, producing organic eggs, creating new markets, strengthening poultry farming, promoting food security, and generating jobs for local youth.

**Project Impact:**

- Engages residents in egg production, promoting ownership and cooperation.
- Trains participants in organic poultry farming using free-range methods and natural supplements.
- Increases egg supply through chemical-free practices that protect the environment.
- Strengthens collaboration with agencies and partners for better support and resource sharing.
- Contributed to SDGs 2, 8, 12 & 15.

**Solution Provider:**

Kelab Belia Komuniti Sungai Haji Dorani was established on 10 July 2015, with the primary focus of developing young people into future community leaders in Kampung Sungai Haji Dorani by planning and executing various youth-related activities. The organization has been recognized as the Most Active Youth NGO in the Sungai Besar Parliament in 2017.

**Project Description:**

- Collaborated on the Projek Penanaman Bakau Persisir Pantai Sungai Haji Dorani, which plants mangrove trees to protect the coast and create habitats for fish, crabs, and shellfish, supporting the local fishing community's income.

**Project Impact:**

- The project strengthened the community's resilience and adaptive capacity to climate-related hazards, specifically by mitigating coastal erosion.
- It improved the local economy by creating opportunities for fishermen to increase their income through the sale of marine life that thrived in the new mangrove habitat.
- The project successfully raised awareness among the local youth, fostering a sense of responsibility for the conservation and sustainable management of the mangrove ecosystem.
- Contributes to SDGs 13, 14 & 15.

**Solution Provider:**

Beringin Natural Farm, established on January 14, 2023, focuses on community development for low-income and high-risk groups through skills training, family development, and income generation. With experience collaborating with government ministries, it now seeks stronger partnerships with NGOs and expert agencies.

**Project Description:**

- Collaborated on the “Pembangunan Kemahiran Elektrik Belia Kasih Bukit Beruntung” project, which addresses the lack of income-generating skills among youths at a rehabilitation center, which causes financial dependency. The project aims to resolve this by equipping participants with a viable trade, enabling them to start a business, become self-reliant, and successfully reintegrate into the community.

**Project Impact:**

- It provided youths in rehabilitation with competent skills in single-phase electrical wiring, which enhanced their ability to be self-reliant.
- The project improved the participants' potential for stable income and reduced unemployment by equipping them with skills relevant to the electrical industry.
- It strengthened collaboration between NGOs and expert agencies, which helped to build a productive image for the participating youths.
- Contributes to SDGs 4, 8 & 17.

Established in 2017 , the Kelab Sukan Dan Kebajikan AADK's main focus is guiding individuals with drug addiction problems, with its members being active rehabilitation officers. The organization collaborates with various departments and NGOs to provide diverse expertise to its clients.

#### Project Description:

- The “Projek Pengembangan Kemahiran dan Kerjaya Klien AADK Kuala Selangor” by Kelab Sukan dan Kebajikan AADK addresses drug addiction through holistic rehabilitation based on the i-Pulih Model, which includes Skills & Vocational Training. It focuses on traditional and modern agriculture, providing career opportunities in a sector suited to the Kuala Selangor area.

#### Project Impact:

- Equipped participants with knowledge and skills in urban agriculture, enabling them to manage a fertigation farm.
- Helped participants build careers, increase household income, and gradually move out of poverty.
- Strengthened participants' resilience in preventing relapse, fulfilling responsibilities, and functioning well in the community.

#### Project Description:

- The Collaborated on the 'Program Literasi Bahasa di Smart Classroom Sjkt Ghandiji' project, which aims to address the challenge of low proficiency in Bahasa Melayu among at-risk students in a Tamil school. The proposed solution is language literacy program in a smart classroom integrating technology to strengthen communication, problem-solving, and emotional regulation skills.

TG Resources Academy was Established in 2017, with the focus on assisting micro-entrepreneurs by providing business training and support. It is also active in disaster relief efforts and builds networks with government agencies and other organizations.

#### Project Description:

- Collaborated on the “Bengkel Asas Membaiki Kasut & SPA Kasut” project, which is proposed to address unemployment and poverty within the Tanjung Karang parliament by introducing skills in the shoe repair and shoe spa industry. As this field is not yet widely popular, the project provides participants with a unique opportunity to gain skills that can generate a high income and potentially lead to careers in shoe design.

#### Project Impact:

- Participants became more confident and enthusiastic about pioneering a business in the shoe repair industry.
- Participants mastered shoe stitching techniques by hand and machine.
- Participants gained real-world business experience by managing a store and handling marketing.

The organization also provides assistance during disasters like floods and offers free tuition for students.

#### Project Description:

- Collaborated on the “Kelas Dandananan Rambut” project, which is a professional hairdressing and hairstylist workshop designed to address limited employment opportunities in Tanjung Karang. It aims to empower local youths and single mothers by providing them with marketable skills in the growing beauty industry, enabling them to find work or start their own businesses locally instead of relocating.

#### Project Impact:

- Provided participants with technical and vocational skills to become professional hairstylists and barbers.
- Created new income-generating opportunities for youths and young single mothers, helping them to escape poverty.
- Increased the number of skilled individuals in the local community, meeting the growing demand for professional hair care services.

- Contributes to SDGs 1, 5 & 8.




