This Directory is more than a compilation of data; it is a reflection of the partnerships, perseverance, and shared vision that define our work. Under the strong support of Dr Siti as Zone Head, and with the tireless dedication of our project officers, Mrs Nur Fatehah Kadir for the Food Security (FS) Unit and Mr Muhammad NorAiman Hakim Bin Ahmad Zaki for the Community-Based Development Project (CBDP) Unit, the East Coast Zone has made remarkable progress in advancing our mandate. Our officers have worked closely with solution providers, not only through structured monthly reporting but by being physically present on the ground, ensuring that projects remain on track and that communities feel supported.

In the Food Security Unit, the East Coast Zone has successfully implemented 30 projects, comprising 16 Agriculture projects, 8 Animal Breeding projects, and 5 Integrated Farming projects. These have been delivered with the expertise and commitment of 29 solution providers, reaching a total of 310 beneficiaries. Each project is designed to address local food needs, strengthen supply chains, and equip communities with the knowledge and resources to secure their own nutritional future. The results demonstrate the value of targeted interventions supported by capable partners who share our vision for a food-secure society.

In the Community-Based Development Project (CBDP) Unit, the East Coast Zone has delivered 50 projects, spanning 24 Social, 25 Economic, and 1 Environmental initiatives. These were made possible through the involvement of 50 solution providers and have benefited 3,085 individuals across 14 parliamentary constituencies. The breadth of this work reflects our commitment to holistic community development, fostering inclusion, economic empowerment, and environmental stewardship. Together, these efforts contribute to a stronger, more

resilient East Coast Zone, equipped to face present challenges and future opportunities.

The organisation's main focus is on community development, and this project involves collaboration with the Pasir Mas District's National Anti-Drugs Agency (AADK), the District Education Office, and other NGOs.

Project Description:

Collaborated on the "Pencegahan Dadah dalam Kawasan Parlimen Rantau Panjang & Daerah Pasir Mas #Lebih Baik Cegah – Komuniti / Sekolah Bebas Dadah" project, which is the second phase of an initiative to combat drug abuse in the Rantau Panjang border area, which has seen a trend in "pil kuda" and lorazepam use.
