In 2024, the All-Party Parliamentary Group Malaysia on Sustainable Development Goals (APPGM-SDG) deepened its grassroots engagement through the expansion of Food Security Initiatives and Community-Based Development Projects (CBDP) across Malaysia. Together, these initiatives reflect APPGM-SDG's commitment in empowering communities, promoting sustainability, and advancing inclusive, locally driven solutions to national challenges.

These initiatives span an inspiring range from programmes that ignite local economies through entrepreneurship and innovation, to social efforts that foster inclusivity, education, and well-being, and environmental projects that safeguard ecosystems and promote responsible resource management.

The success of these Northern projects is a testament to the leadership and dedication of the officers and teams driving them. Vikneswaran Sunderam and Kartiga Kanna Dasan, Officers for Community-Based Development Projects in charge of the Northern Zone, provided steadfast leadership and coordination, ensuring that local partnerships and governance mechanisms remained strong and transparent. Serving as Director of the Project Management Department under the All-Party Parliamentary Group Malaysia on Sustainable Development Goals (APPGM-SDG), I am honoured to introduce the North Zone Directory, a tribute to the solution providers and officers whose dedication has transformed our initiatives into lasting community impact.

This Directory is more than a compilation of data, it is a reflection of the partnerships, perseverance, and shared vision that define our work. Under the strong support of Dr. Thanaraj Murudi as Zone Head, and with the tireless dedication of our project officers, Vikneswaran Sunderam together with Kartiga Kanna Dasan for the Community-Based Development Project (CBDP) and Unit Rose Helen Ambrose for the Food Security (FS) Unit, the North Zone has made remarkable progress in advancing our mandate. Our officers have worked closely with solution providers, not only through structured monthly reporting but by being physically present on the ground, ensuring that projects remain on track and that communities feel supported.

In the Community-Based Development Project (CBDP) Unit, the North Zone has delivered 96 projects, spanning 34 Social, 60 Economic, and 2 Environmental initiatives. These were made possible through the involvement of 96 solution providers and have benefited 3,222 participants across 37 parliamentary constituencies. This extensive reach reflects the North Zone's commitment to inclusive and sustainable growth, enhancing livelihoods, supporting entrepreneurship, and promoting environmental care.

In the Food Security Unit, the North Zone has successfully implemented 30 projects, comprising 26 Farming (Agriculture) projects and 4 Animal Breeding projects. These have been delivered with the expertise and commitment of 30 solution providers, reaching a total of 310 beneficiaries. Each initiative focuses on strengthening local food production capacity, increasing access to fresh produce and protein sources, and equipping communities with the skills and tools necessary to maintain self-sufficiency in the long term.

These numbers tell a powerful story. With 57 projects implemented across two major units, supported by 59 dedicated solution providers, the South Zone has touched the lives of 1,682 beneficiaries. This is not only a testament to the hard work of our officers and partners but also an illustration of SDG 17 in action, forging partnerships that multiply impact and bring tangible improvements to communities. Every figure represents real change, built through trust, collaboration, and shared responsibility between APPGM-SDG, our solution providers, and the communities we serve.
