These initiatives span an inspiring range from programmes that ignite local economies through entrepreneurship and innovation, to social efforts that foster inclusivity, education, and well-being, and environmental projects that safeguard ecosystems and promote responsible resource management.

The success of these Sarawak Region projects is a testament to the leadership and dedication of the officers and teams driving them. Corrin Alicia Nero, as the Project Officer for Food Security and Community Based Developments Unit played a pivotal role in ensuring that every initiative was effectively managed, closely monitored, and aligned with the principles of inclusivity and sustainability.

Under my direction, and with the strong support of Sarawak Region Head, Raine Melissa Riman, our dedicated project officer, Corrin Alicia Nero, who oversees both the Food Security (FS) Unit and the Community-Based Development Project (CBDP) Unit, has demonstrated exceptional commitment in implementing and monitoring projects. Her responsibilities have gone far beyond administrative oversight, she has worked closely with our solution providers through regular monthly monitoring, and has gone on the ground to observe, assess and support project activities. These efforts have ensured that every initiative remains aligned with our objectives and responsive to community needs.

Equally, I extend my deepest appreciation to our solution providers, whose dedication to partnership embodies the spirit of SDG 17, Partnerships for the Goals. In the Food Security (FS) Unit, the Sarawak Region has successfully implemented 31 projects, comprising 23 farming initiatives, 4 animal breeding projects and 4 integrated farming projects. These have been delivered with the expertise and commitment of 28 solution providers, reaching a total of 358 beneficiaries. Each project is designed to address local food needs, strengthen supply chains and equip communities with the knowledge and resources to secure their own nutritional future. The range of projects from conventional and modern farming to integrated systems, demonstrates our adaptability in meeting diverse community needs and local conditions.

In the Community-Based Development Project (CBDP) Unit, the Sarawak Region has delivered 37 projects, spanning 11 social, 24 economic and 2 environmental initiatives. These were made possible through the involvement of 33 solution providers and have benefited 1,207 individuals across 17 parliamentary constituencies. The breadth of this work reflects our commitment to holistic community development, fostering inclusion, economic empowerment and environmental stewardship. Together, these efforts contribute to a stronger, more resilient Sarawak Region, equipped to face present challenges and future opportunities.

Solution Provider:

The Organization for Addiction Prevention Treatment and Rehabilitation (OAPTAR) is a non-governmental organisation established in October 2019. It is dedicated to implementing evidence-based prevention interventions that promote the healthy development of children and youth, while also supporting the overall wellbeing of families and communities.

Project Description:

- Collaborated on "Wellness Champion Program", a school-based drug prevention initiative designed to provide age-appropriate information on drug use and its harmful effects. The program also aimed to equip secondary school students with essential life skills to help them navigate challenges, make informed decisions, and manage their lives in positive and constructive ways.

Project Impact:

- Participants developed greater self-awareness, self-confidence, and social-emotional skills, contributing to increased resilience in managing personal and academic challenges.
- Enhanced participants' knowledge of drug use and its consequences, while strengthening their social and emotional skills to support informed decision-making.
- Contributed to SDGs 3, 4 & 5.

Jawatankuasa Pembangunan Gunung Orad was formed in 2024. The committee has experience in managing community-focused initiatives, including the successful organisation of the KRT Program in 2021 and the Orad Carnival event in 2019

Project Description:

- Collaborated on the "Community-Based Tourism—Bung Orad Hiking Trail" project which aimed to enhance eco-tourism by improving the trail's safety and accessibility. The initiative sought to attract more visitors, stimulate the local economy, create job opportunities, and promote sustainable tourism practices.

Project Impact:

- Increased number of visitors and hikers to Gunung Orad, boosting tourism activity in the area.
- Generated higher revenue through admission fees, contributing to the local economy.

Eqnis Bakery Cafe, established in 2020, is led by an experienced entrepreneur in the processing and distribution of traditional food, with a strong background in conducting cooking and catering classes.

Project Description:

- Collaborated on "Program Memasak (Katering)", which aimed to enhance participants' cooking skills as a means to generate additional income and stimulate the local economy. The programme provided training in cooking techniques and food preparation, along with basic entrepreneurial skills to enable participants to sell food either through stalls or catering services.

Project Impact:

- Participants demonstrated stronger teamwork, communication, and interpersonal skills through group-based activities.
- The project created opportunities for income generation, encouraging entrepreneurship and strengthening the local economy.
- Through hands-on learning and practical experiences, participants gained greater confidence in their abilities and were more motivated to pursue personal and economic goals

Solution Provider:

Established in 2015, Fly Technology Agriculture (WormingUp) promotes sustainable farming and environmental care by raising community awareness on reducing chemical use, protecting resources, and improving agricultural yields.

Project Description

- Collaborated on the “Mempromosikan Agroekologi: Meningkatkan Kemampuan Alam Sekitar dan Peluang Rezeki Untuk Komuniti” project. This project aimed to introduce agroecological farming as a sustainable alternative to conventional, chemical-dependent agriculture. The approach emphasises working in harmony with natural systems through practices such as intercropping, crop rotation, and the use of organic inputs.

Project Impact:

- The project increased participants' awareness of sustainable farming practices.
- By introducing practical, hands-on training, the project encouraged farmers to adopt agroecological methods such as organic fertilisation, crop rotation, and natural pest control leading to more environmentally sustainable farms.
- The project helped farmers increase their productivity and profitability, contributing to improved household income and long-term livelihood sustainability.

Tokum Community Development Association (TCDA) develops idle NCR land, protects it from encroachment, and promotes income through regenerative farming, eco-tourism, and marketing community farm products.

Project Description

- Collaborated on the Organic Ginger Farming project. The primary aim of the project is to create income-generating opportunities through sustainable ginger farming, utilising organic practices that enhance productivity and food security.

Project Impact:

- The project developed about 1 hectare of organic ginger farmland, yielding roughly 12,000 kg and providing both local food supply and sustainable income for participants.
- Throughout the implementation, participants demonstrated practical knowledge and skills in good organic farming practices, including soil management, natural pest control, and sustainable cultivation techniques.
- A community cooperative was formed to manage resources, improve market access, and ensure the long-term growth of the organic ginger farming initiative.
- Contribute to SDGs 1, 2 & 4.

The company serves as an intermediary to help local residents market their products, thereby boosting their earnings, supporting their livelihoods, and increasing household income.

Project Description

- Collaborated on the "Tanaman Fertigasi Cili Merah" project, which is built upon the success of the Phase 1 project where participants managed to harvest 150 kg of chilli, which was successfully marketed locally. This Phase 2 project aimed to expand the chilli plantation and introduce value-added chili products such as dried chili, chili paste, and sambal.

Project Impact:

- The project enabled participants to generate an estimated monthly income of around RM500, providing meaningful financial support to their households.
- Participants gained practical agricultural knowledge and developed a strong interest in farming.
- The project helped reduce unemployment, particularly among youth, by encouraging participation in agriculture.
- Contribute to SDGs 1, 2 & 3.

- The training equipped local artisans with advanced techniques such as fine weaving and beadwork, resulting in higher-quality, more refined products.
- Participants successfully developed new types of handicrafts that command higher prices. Many have since diversified their income streams by selling products online, at craft fairs, and to tourists.

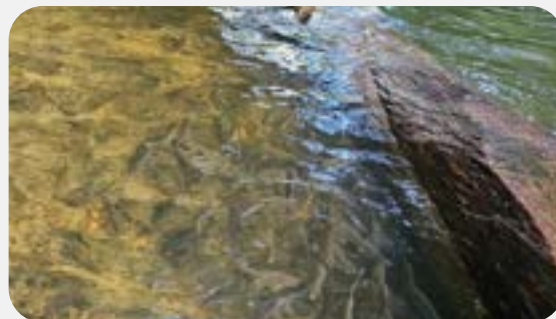
