In 2024, the All-Party Parliamentary Group Malaysia on Sustainable Development Goals (APPGM-SDG) deepened its grassroots engagement through the expansion of Food Security Initiatives and Community-Based Development Projects (CBDP) across Malaysia. These initiatives span an inspiring range from programmes that ignite local economies through entrepreneurship and innovation, to social efforts that foster inclusivity, education, and well-being, and environmental projects that safeguard ecosystems and promote responsible resource management.

The success of these Southern projects is a testament to the leadership and dedication of the officers and teams driving them. Darshini Rawichandran, as the Project Officer for Food Security, played a pivotal role in ensuring that every initiative was effectively managed, closely monitored, and aligned with the principles of inclusivity and sustainability. Yoogeswaran Kanis, Project Officer in Charge of the Southern Zone, provided steadfast leadership in management and monitoring of Community based Developments Projects, ensuring that local partnerships and governance mechanisms remained strong and transparent.

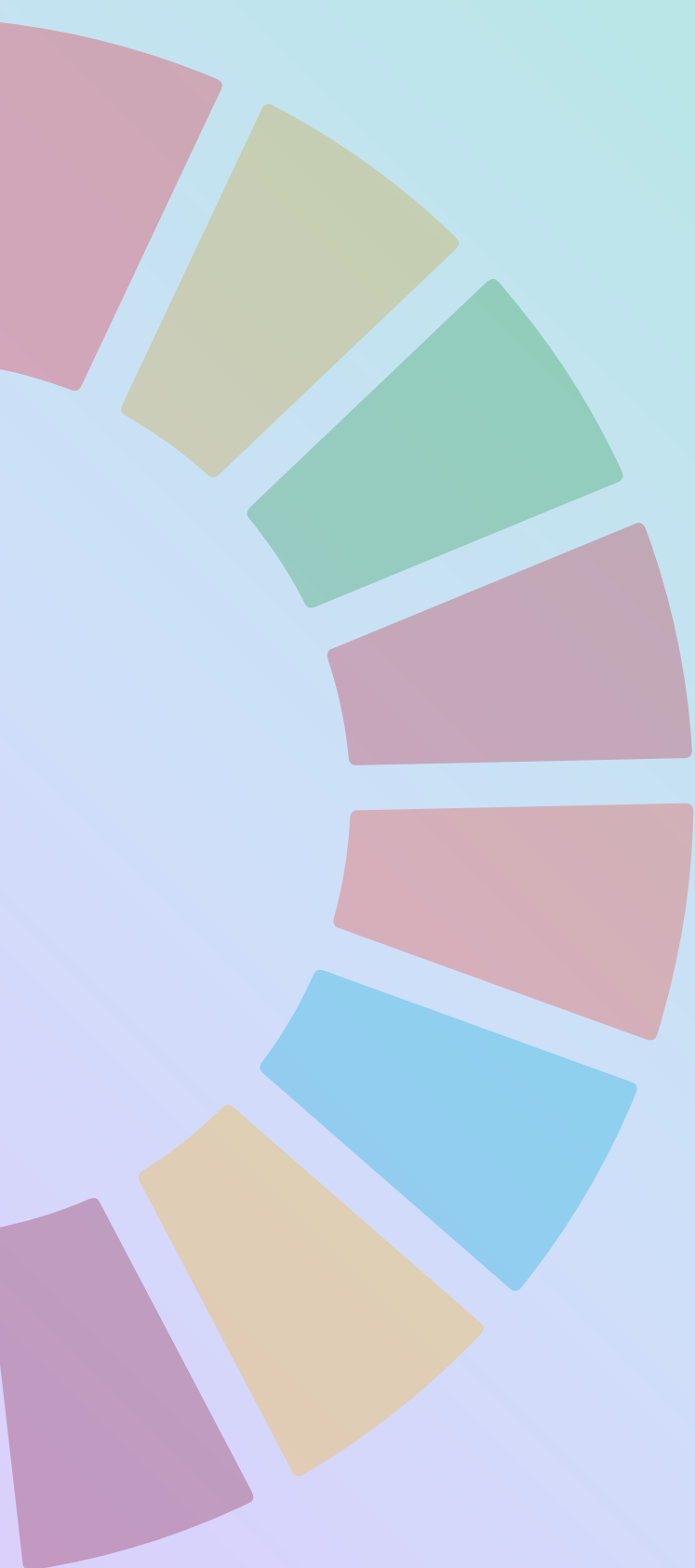

Each project is designed to address local food needs, strengthen supply chains, and equip communities with the knowledge and resources to secure their own nutritional future. The results demonstrate the value of targeted interventions supported by capable partners who share our vision for a food-secure society.

In the Community-Based Development Project (CBDP) Unit, the South Zone has delivered 40 projects, spanning 18 Social and 25 Economy projects. These were made possible through the involvement of 42 solution providers and have benefited 1,512 individuals across 21 parliamentary constituencies. The breadth of this work reflects our commitment to holistic community development, fostering inclusion, economic empowerment, and environmental stewardship. Together, these efforts contribute to a stronger, more resilient South Zone, equipped to face present challenges and future opportunities.

- Contributes to SDG 1, 8 & 12.

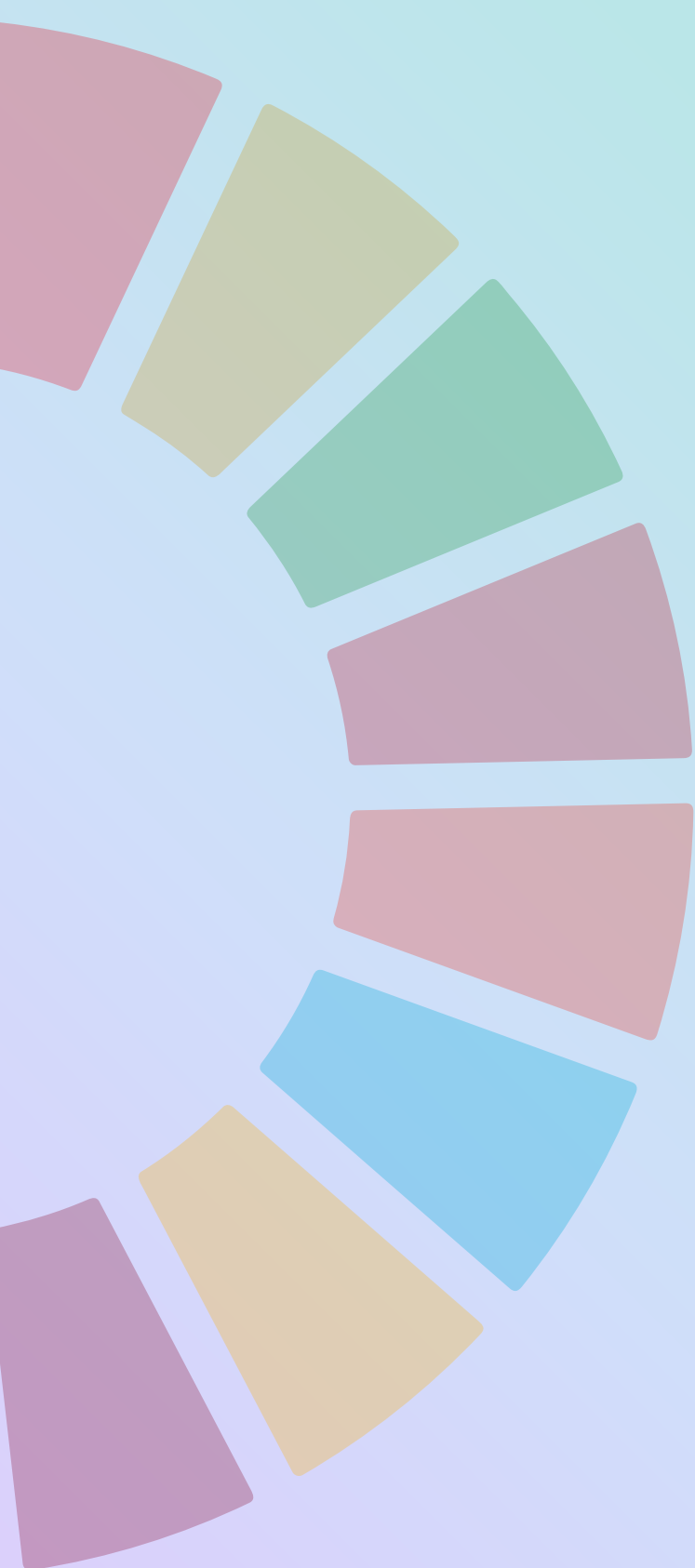
